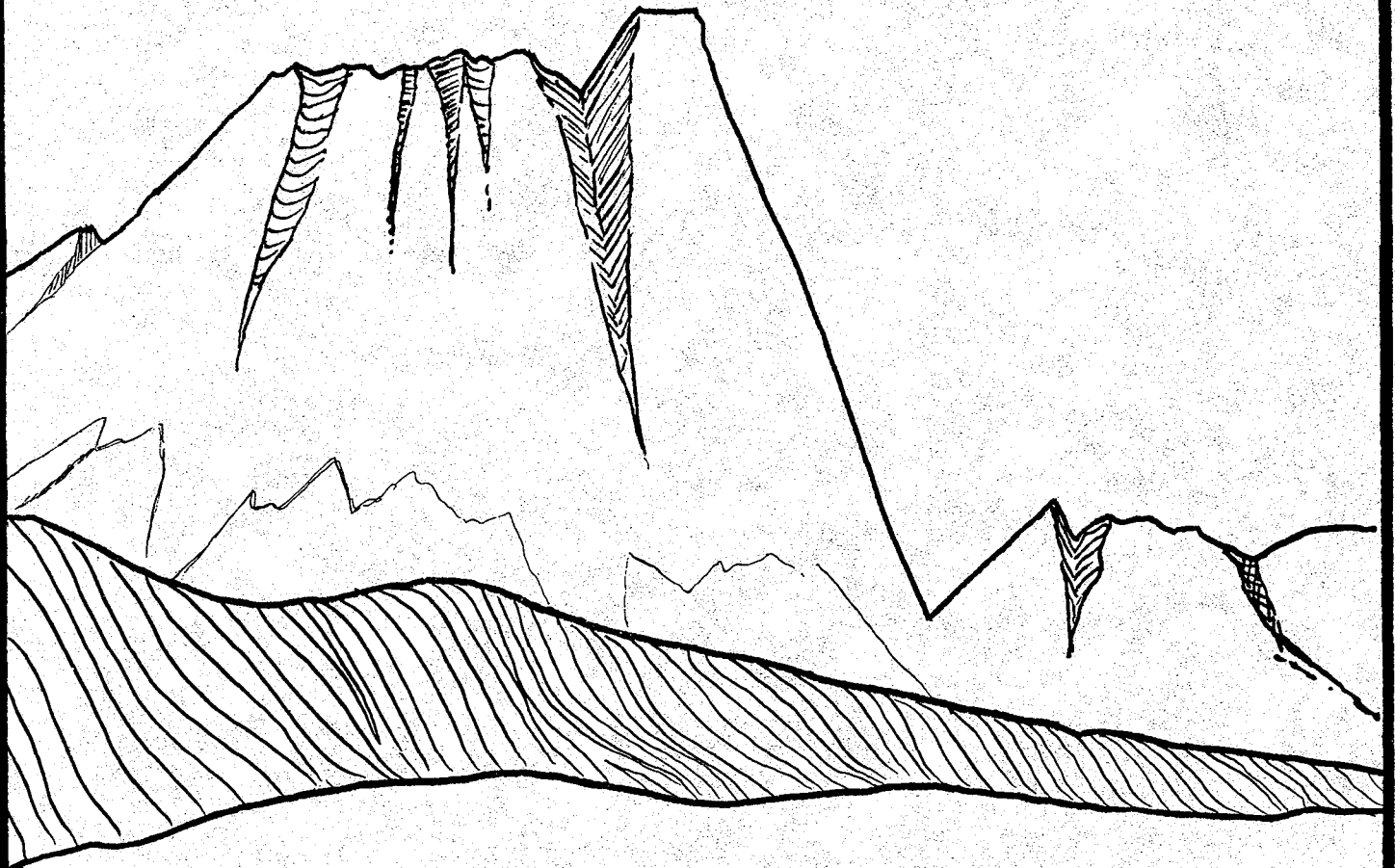

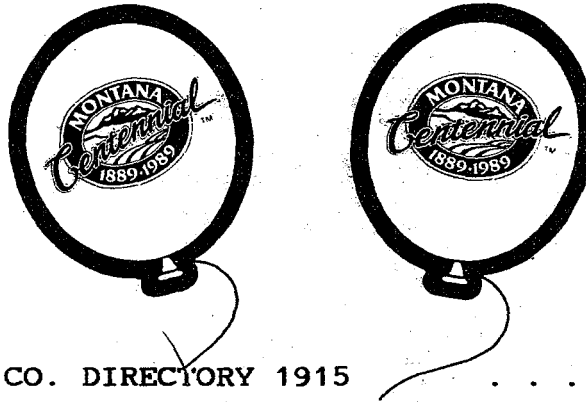

The following was taken from the "FENTON'S HILL COUNTY DIRECTORY BUREAU OF INFORMATION AND TAX PAYER GUILDE OF 1915-1916" by E. B. & J. H. FENTON PUBLISHERS.

BURNHAM

A station on the main line of the Great Northern Railway, 10 miles west of the county seat. Has a post office and general store. Mrs. M. C. Moss, P. M. General store, F.D. McSloy, Propr.

BUELOWS

4 miles east of Chester on the Great Northern, has a post office and general store. Mary Buelow, P. M. ; Buelow A. H., general store and lumber.

CHESTER

The enterprising little city of Chester with a population of 800, is located on the main line of the Great Northern Railway, 65 miles west of Havre, the county seat of Hill County, and is the second town in size in the county. It is also the only incorporated city in the county, besides Havre.

Chester is the principal trading and shipping point for the great cattle and sheep ranches of the famous Sweet Grass Hills country, as well as for the hundreds of farmers and homesteaders,

who have settled on the rich prairie lands between the Sweet Grass Hills and the Marias River.

These prairie lands, which are just beginning to be developed are proving wondrously fertile and while the principal crops attempted so far have been wheat, oats and flax, it has been demonstrated that corn, potatoes, root crops of all kinds, as well as alfalfa, can be profitably grown.

These demonstrations confirm the prediction, that diversified farming will within a very few years be the rule, instead of the exception, and that this part of Montana will take its proper place as one of the richest farming regions in our great country.

The business men and citizens of Chester have shown their confidence in the future of this section by building for the future. This is shown by the great activity displayed in the last three years in the building of schools, churches and residences as well as by the installation of telephone systems and water works.

The water works just completed during the last year is a complete up at date system, comprising a 50,000 gallon steel tank and about two miles of mains, which, with an unlimited supply of fine water, plenty of fire hose, and a well organized volunteer fire department, insures health and safety of all the city.

The telephone system in addition to a large and well organized local exchange, has over 175 miles of rural lines, giving excellent service to all surrounding towns and ranches; this system is growing very rapidly, new lines are being built every season.

THE CHESTER FLOUR MILL.

Mr. C. E. Biggs one of the enterprising citizens of Chester has just completed a three story flour mill with a capacity of from 30 to 50 barrels per day, and a bin capacity of 4,000 bushels. The machinery is of the type known as the 'Self Contain Short System' and is designated as the 'Midget marvel' made by the Angle American Milling Co., of Owensborough, Ky. There are several mills

of this kind in operation in the state making the highest grade flour. The mill has the very latest and recently improved roller system--which should make it one of the best mills in the state. In addition to making wheat ground feed of all kinds and the usual milling by products.

Mr. Biggs is a practical miller and will operate the mill himself. With this large 'Flour Mill and the large St. A. & Dak. Elevator," Chester should be one of the best grain markets in Northern Montana.

Nothing in any community so well indicates the capacity for growth and development of the schools of that community. Chester has the most progressive, most up to date schools of any town or city of the same size in the state of Montana; five teachers lead, and direct the energies of one hundred and twenty-five pupils. Three years of high school work are offered and a fourth is soon to be added.

In 1912 a new \$15,000.00 building was erected; this building is thoroughly up to date in every respect; it is built of grey pressed brick; it is heated by steam, is wired for electric lights, and is connected to the city water system. The pupils have plenty of heat, plenty of light; plenty of water, plenty of floor space, plenty of air; they also have plenty of enthusiasm that enables them to do their work day by day as it comes to them. The people of Chester are justly proud of their schools; they are proud of the record their children have made and are making in the things that count in school work.

In addition to the above named public and semi-public enterprises, Chester has three large general stores, one grocery store, one drug store, three lumber yards, one hardware store, two implement warehouses, two livery and feed stables, three barber shops, two good hotels, two restaurants, one meat market, blacksmith shop, automobile garage, moving picture show, one up to date newspaper, and two of the strongest banks in the county.

All this combined with energy, public spirit, progressiveness, and confidence in the future of this city, which is a part of the mental equipment of every one of her citizens, warrants the warning, "Keep Your Eyes on Chester."

GILDFORD

Gildford, (the central city of the Big Sage county, estimated population 300). Located 30 miles west of Havre, the county seat on the main line of the Great northern Railway where it intersects and crosses Big Sage Creek. In the Center of some 800,000 acres of what might be called the (CHOCOLATE LOAM DISTRICT) and extends 30 miles north to the Canadian Boundary and 25 miles south to the Montana Central Railway. It is one of the oldest towns on what is known as the Great Northern High Line; and for many years was the trading point for ranchers and stockmen, covering that section of country on Sage Creek and Upper Milk River.

The lands surrounding Gildford has all been homesteaded and settled upon by a progressive, prosperous and contented set of farmers who for the past five years have raised good crops of wheat, oats, barley, flax, rye, corn and vegetables.

Added to its wonderfully fertile and productive soil is, its ideal climate and its bountiful supply of good water for domestic and other purposes which may be found at a reasonable depth on every farm.

Another feature which makes Gildford an ideal place to locate is its proximity to the mountains on the west. A few hours' ride on the Great Northern Oriental Limited brings you to the foot of the main range of the mighty Rockies and the gate to Glacier National Park. The pride of the town is its splendid school house which was built at a cost of upwards of \$7,000.00 and is up to the highest degree of expectancy in its efficient and excellent work in all the grades.

A handsome new Episcopal Church has just been completed, and other churches of the different denominations are now planned and will be built within the coming year.

Its Commercial Club is a real live organization and will be found prompt and accommodating in answering questions concerning the town and country and cooperate with all forward movements.

It is said that 92 cars of grain was shipped from this point during the months of September and October.

Gildford was the first town in the county to erect a flour mill which is another evidence of the enterprise and thrift of its citizens. The flour mill has capacity of 40 barrels daily and is running to its full capacity, making first class flour and other by products which is being supplied to Hill County farmers and others.
