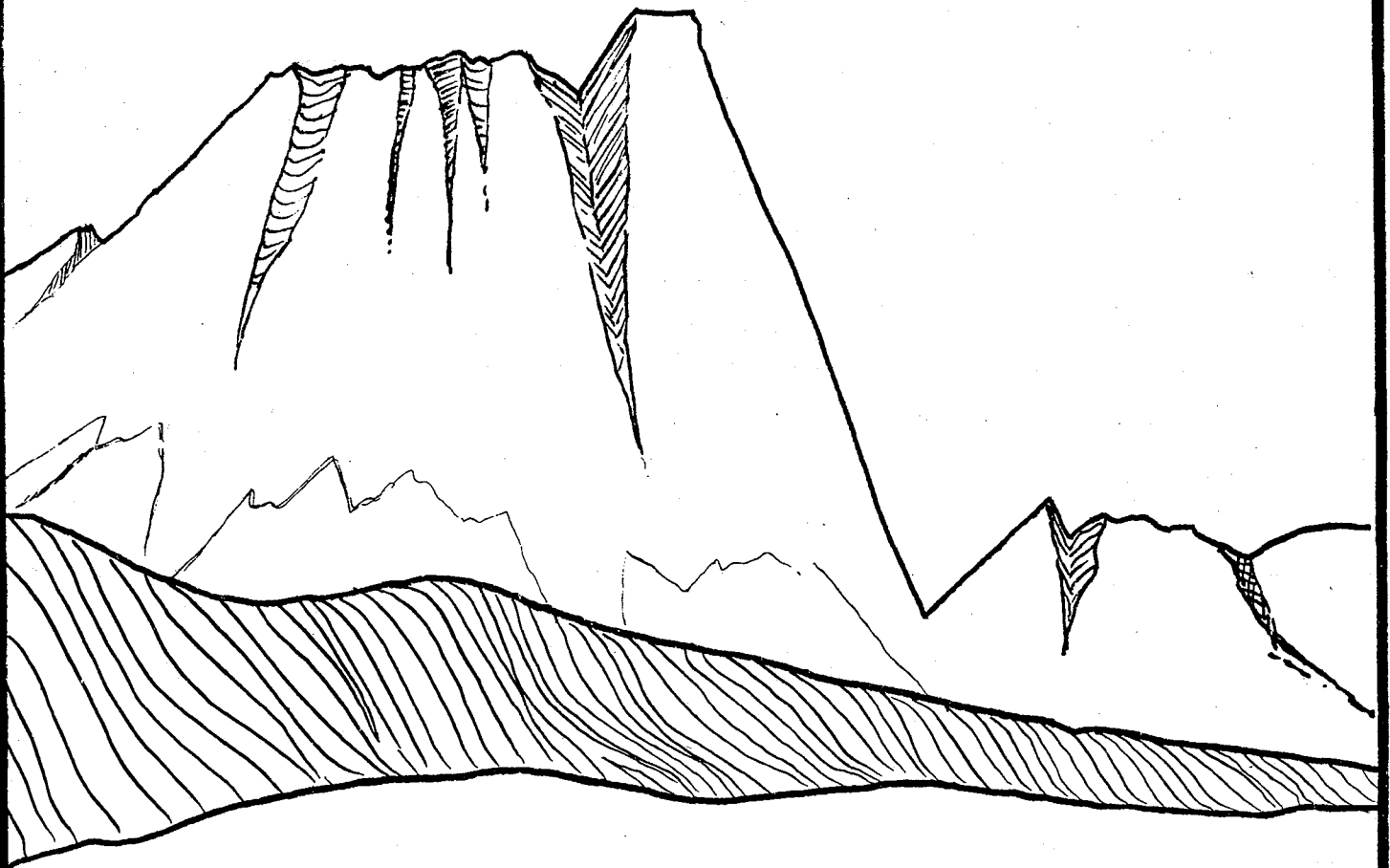

INTRODUCTION

LONG AGO IN LIBERTY

Have you not wondered what it must have been like before the railroad and highways, the fences, the fields and the towns? Gaze, if you will from a high hill in Liberty County. Think how Captain Lewis and his men must have seen this land-as "Oceans of Grass," The Rockies to the west, Bear Paws to the east, Highwoods and Knees to the south and the Sweetgrass Hills to the north; and every where herds of buffalo and multiple Indian camps.

It was in 1806 when Captain Lewis first saw the area and how could he then have perceived what future their expedition would bring to the land. Maybe he could foresee the fur trading becoming significant with the abundant beaver and buffalo but for such an untamed land, surely he did not have the notion of railroads bringing communities and rural industries so soon after.

Nor did this scientist captain realize all the history which had passed long before his footprints. Little by little we are discovering the vastness of God's creation and the years He took to prepare the perfect universe for His people. As the waters of the 1964 flood receded on the shores of Tiber Lake, this author was amazed what the ancient pages (broken rocks) revealed. Truly it was exciting to see impressions of

marine life from the ancient ones.

Today's farmers, as they clean their fields of stone probably do not know the ancient history they throw onto their trucks, such as sand rocks which have for thousands of years preserved the leaves and stems of once tropical plants. Because of the fossilized snails and shells of salt water life which can be found most anywhere in this county, it is quite evident once a Great Sea of salt water covered the area. Scientists then say there were ice glaciers, the Pleistocene era, which seemed to have responded to some unexplainable climatic control, causing the spread and retreat of ice at intervals; this then explains the large round stones in the foothills of East Butte, the well polished stones on the prairie and the outcroppings of the glacier marine in township 28 and range 7 east. Palentologists and archaeologists state the last ice age was about 13,000 B.C. to 11,000 B.C. for Northern Montana. Then there is the record of Creation and the Great Flood which seems to correlate with the scientists geological timetable except for dating. The hypotheses, theories and facts boggle the mind, but should anyone be interested to pursue the truth of how our phenomenal earth began, Liberty County holds a few pieces of that great puzzle.

DINOSAURS

Speaking of pieces to this puzzle of what happened years ago, how about the monstrous dinosaurs and the giant bison. Years, they were here as evident from the fossil findings along Laird Creek and the surrounding coulees. They no longer tread the area (except maybe for Big Foot) but his

fossil remains deeply embedded in Liberty's soils are now the oil and gas deposits found in Bear's Den, Flat Coulee, Snoose Coulee and the Whitlash area. No wonder the professor in Science from an eastern university (who stayed the summers sometime before 1910 at the Hill Hotel and scouted the "hills") repeatedly told Karl Jeppesen that the Sweetgrass Hills held something special. But he did not say what his speculation was, leaving the excitement of discovery to someone else. Was it the Great Salt Sea, the ice glaciers, the Biblical Flood or all three which crushed these giant two brained animals and the tropical plants deep into Liberty's underground.

THE SWEETGRASS HILLS

More questions. How and when did the Sweetgrass Hills come about? Geologists can only theorize from the information oil and mining companies have found and one possibility was told: that Grassy Butte (Toole County) southwest of East Butte, (Liberty County) was once the cone of a volcanic eruption pushing from earth's inner surface the three mountains, West Butte, and Middle Butte of Toole County and East Butte. This eruption also caused the Milk River, which once flowed south through the upper parts of Toole and Liberty Counties, to change course going north into Canada. This then left behind sand rock formations as the Bear's Den and several caves such as Devil's Chimney and Seven-room Cave. Further evidence that this area may be part of the old Milk River bed is that Tootsie Creek disappears into the ground. Adjacent to this mystery is a meadow which animals avoid for they feel a trembling as if

the ground were hollow underneath. Prescott's sheepherders never stayed long as more than once they were frightened by the rumble below the meadow, and even today, the rancher's horse will not cross the area nor will cattle.

If this is not the old Milk River it would possibly then be a preglacial drainage which was covered over but not filled in with glacial deposits. The volcanic theory seems to support the possibility that at the time of the eruption portions of the Preglacial stream beds were lifted up and put out of reach of the ice glaciers, thus, leaving them as caves. According to the research done for Montana Water Resources Survey of 1969, the ice glaciers did not cover the Sweetgrass Hills but moved up to the elevations between 3 and 4,000 feet. As for the plains below the "hills" the Keewatin ice sheet which developed in central Canada during the late Wisconsin period of Glaciation spread over the plains of Liberty County (except for the higher elevation of Dobie Ridge) and influenced the variety of soils found in the county.

What is the geological make-up of East Butte? From the Montana Bureau of Mines and again from the Montana Resources Survey, East Butte is mostly Post-Madison sedimentary rocks...mainly rock as limestone, sandrocks and shale from the Mesozoric age. At the foothills and beyond are the Pleistocene glacial deposits. There is a small amount of Metamorphic rock, rock which has changed from one form to another through pressure and heat or chemical action... that would be the white marble which can be seen on the south side of Mt. Royal. The upper portions of the peaks are of igneous rock, that which is unstratified crystalline rock which forms the core and foundation of the earth. So the

question arises, "Is this igneous rock pushed up from the core of the earth due to glacial pressure or did it come from the volcanic eruption?"

Collectively the several mounts in Liberty County are called "East Butte." The mounts are named Mt. Royal and its elevation goes up to 6,914 feet and supports several radio towers. Mt. Brown, the highest is 6,958 feet and north of Mt. Royal one and a half miles; to the east is a mount called East Butte and its highest elevation as 6,566 feet. About 3 miles east of the mount East Butte is Mt. Lebanon, 5,807 feet. Independently standing 4 miles southwest of Mt. Royal is Hay Stack Butte, 4,737. The higher mounts have timber but lower elevation are grassy slopes.

FIRST DISCOVERY OF SWEETGRASS HILLS

The Lewis and Clark Expedition report recorded "Broken Mountains" for the three mountains in Toole and Liberty Counties. Between 1849-1853 Issac Ingall Stevens was sent to explore and survey the western territory even more extensively than Lewis and Clark. It is not known if his artist and photographer, John Max Stanley, was along with Stevens when he scouted the Sweetgrass Hills in 1853. This was one of Steven's last explorations before becoming governor of the Western territory. Stevens recorded the "hills" as "Trois Buttes" same as the early French-Canadian fur trappers had marked their maps. Verbally the French-Canadian trappers called them "Montagnes du Foine de Senteur" who had heard the Indians refer to them as "Hills of Sweet Smelling Grass," thus the name Sweetgrass Hills came to be.

Correctly speaking the Sweetgrass Hills are mountains, not hills, or

buttes, because of their height and geological make-up, however the trappers identity stuck above Captain Lewis' correct title," Broken Mountains."

CATTLEMEN AND SHEEPMEN

Before 1889 the area was still Blackfoot Reserve. Beginning in 1883 large cattle companies in Montana obtained government grazing permits to graze cattle on the reservation. If the cattleman was married to an Indian, "squaw-man," he could graze without a permit until the government squelched that law "loop-hole." After the government purchased the reserve it was "open range" for all companies. With the disappearance of the buffalo, the buffalo or sweet grass was abundant and large herds moved in. Names of some of the larger outfits were Circle Diamond, F. Triangle owned by Dan Floweree of Helena, and the DHS outfit owned by Con Kohrs and two men from Deer Lodge. The XIT moved into the Marias-Sweetgrass Hills ranges in the late 1880's as their 3 million acre spread in Texas didn't have the special grass like the Sweetgrass Hills. Con Price, Charlie Russell's partner at West Butte said, "I have seen steers so fat we could hardly drive them into the roundups after grazing for a summer on the grass in the Sweetgrass Hills."

The outfits trailed the livestock into the area crossing many rivers enroute. Dohrs, a Belgium immigrant, trailed his sheep from Missouri to Bear Gulch. Charles Hawley, as early as 1871, drove horses from California to the "Hills." Alexanders came in 1888 with cattle. Wigmore, 1902, trailed 3000 head of cattle from Cheyenne, Wyoming to his place

near Whitlash.

Somehow the "free" had its costs. The May storm of 1903 piled snow deep in the coulees, dead and half alive animals were found as far south as Ft. Benton. Dohrs lost 1500 head. A sheepherder lost his life. Prairie fires were not uncommon, the one in 1903 destroyed considerable grass country.

In 1893 cattle prices were \$15.00 per head, and always there was cattle stealing. Discouraged the larger companies shipped their cattle out from Chester or Galata leaving the range for the smaller ranchers who were taking up "squatter's rights." Those remaining in the "Hills" were Price on the Company C Ranch, Prescotts on the Davis-Joiner Ranch, Bourne-Hamilton, Arnez Droz, Tom Strode with the first sheep and Lairds. On the Marias were the Pugsleys on the Wright Ranch, Brinkmans, Circle Ranch and Trommers. These ranchers had a gentlemen's agreement as to water-rights on the creeks and coulees. When the "sod busters" arrived the cowboys pulled their hats over eyes for they didn't like seeing what they saw. Bobbed Wire Benny was enroute in his rickety old green buggy selling barbed wire. Between 1888 and 1914 he sold over \$1,000,000 worth of barbed wire between Fargo, North Dakota and Shelby, Montana.

The cutting of fences, and the cattle rustling took place; the horse thieves, cut-throats and desperadoes were once here. There is no doubt about it, Liberty County was once part of the Wild West.
