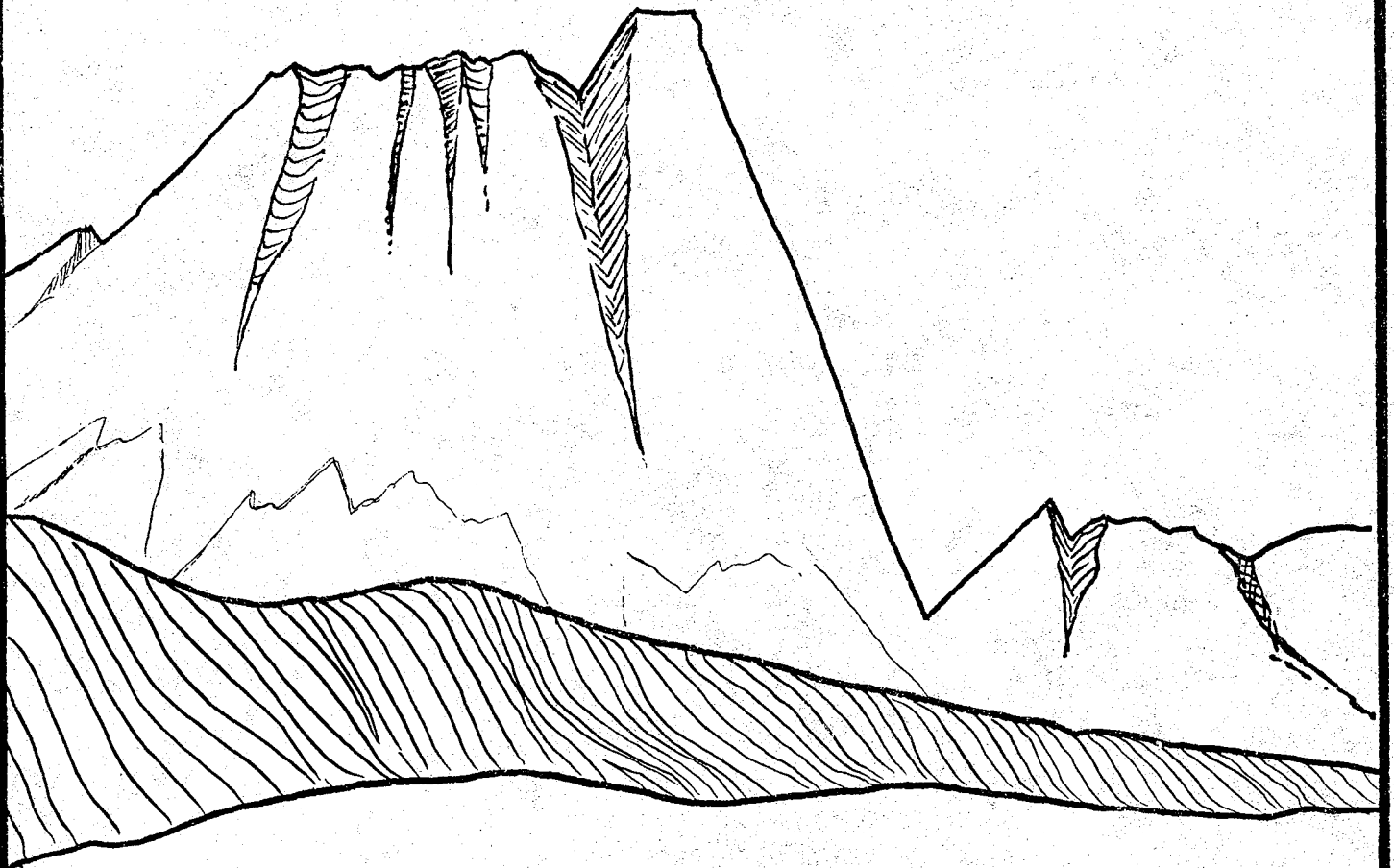



MEETINGS: Meetings are held the first Thursday of every month except July and August, at the Liberty County Library, Chester, Mt. At 7:30 p.m.

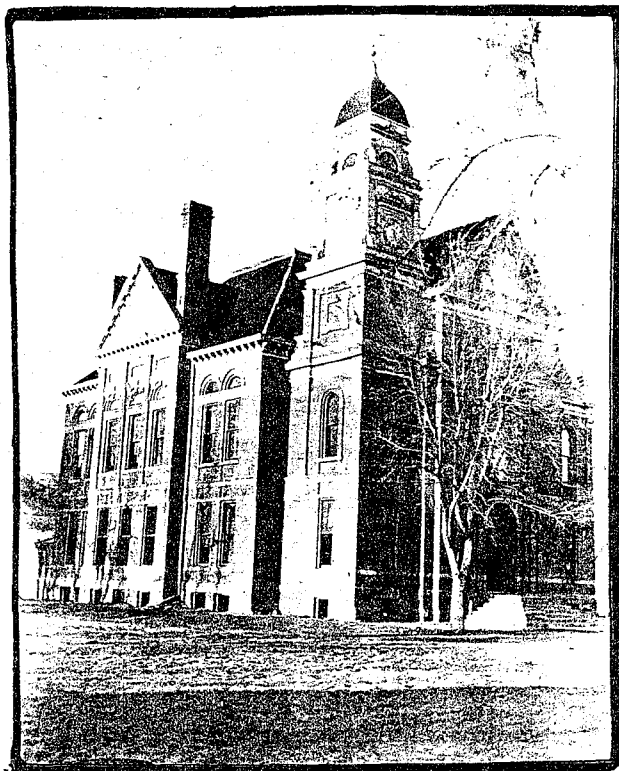

OUR PARENT COUNTY COURTHOUSE
FORT BENTON, CHOUTEAU, MONTANA

Montana Territory became an organized Territory in 1864. What is now Liberty County was part of Montana Territory, became part of Chouteau County in 1865, part of Hill County from 1912 until 1920-when Liberty County was formed. Chester is our county seat, but a fairly new town compared to Fort Benton. In the early days, Chester was just a little rest stop along Cottonwood Coulee for people traveling from Fort Benton to Gold Butte and Whitlash, in the Sweet-grass Hills.

This is the courthouse of our parent county-Chouteau County. We are proud to have been a part of its history. What a long and hard journey it must have been for our forefathers to reach Fort Benton by horseback or wagon, across hills and miles of prairie and to cross the Teton and Marias Rivers before bridges were built. The bad flood of 1908 took out what little accommodations there were for crossing.

Fort Benton is an attractive, tree lined, frontier town, lying along the Missouri River. Many barges and steamships came up the river to Fort Benton in the early years, carrying supplies for the territory. All that remains of the old fort, is a small, square, rock building that sits in the city park along the "Mighty Missouri".

My husband's great grandfather, Herman Brinkman, who with his wife and family came here in 1866 or 1867, got his naturalization papers in Fort Benton. His grandparents, Thomas Francis Morgan and Edith Brinkman, got their wedding license at this courthouse in 1885. The Brinkman addition was named after Herman Brinkman. Thomas Morgan was here in 1875 and worked for T. C. Powers & Bros. and in 1885 became a partner in their Stanford store. The Morgans had four of their children born in Fort Benton.

Herman and Marie Brinkman and Thomas Morgan lie peacefully in their graves, in the attractive cemetery on the hill. A section of soldier's graves in this cemetery, are a reminder of the history of Fort Benton.

It is little wonder that I never enter this pleasant, picturesque, older courthouse, without a feeling of awe and give a silent salute to the pioneers whose records are documented here.

CHOUTEAU COUNTY COURTHOUSE

100 years of Service

1884-1984

Standing as center of government for the past 100 years, the Chouteau County Courthouse has witnessed many changes, yet has remained basically unchanged since its construction in 1884.

The present brick structure was not the first courthouse for the county. One of the nine original counties created by an act of the territorial legislature, February 21, 1865, was Chouteau County. The name was then spelled "Choteau". There was a courthouse in Fort Benton as early as 1870. A more modern courthouse was authorized in 1879 and built and completed in 1880. In 1881, the present jail was constructed. January 5, 1883, the courthouse burned along with the Foster saloon. When the vault of the courthouse was opened, the county records were found to be intact. However, the temporary storage of the records was such that they had been in disarray since those early years. While there were some records that date prior to 1883, they are very incomplete.

With the loss of the courthouse, local citizens noted the need for a new building and one was quickly authorized. On June 20, 1883, county commissioners J. S. Hill, James Arnoux and W. S. Wetzel opened bids for the new structure. There was a difference of over 20,000 dollars in the two bids, which was a surprise to all. The commissioners took the bids under advisement in effort to determine which bid would yield the quality they wanted.

It would seem that the comments made by a local newspaper favored one contractor over another, "Mr. Senieur has erected a number of the best buildings in Fort Benton and he doubtless knows what he can do this work for. He is, of course, entitled to the contract, if he and his friends continue in the faith that the house can be built for that money, which will be a nice thing for the county". The papers favorable support of Mr. Gus Senieur must have payed off, as he was awarded the bid at \$43,300.

Architect for the building was Kees and Fisk of Minneapolis. The inside of the structure was decorated like the Syndicate Block of Minneapolis. Sam Houston and Charles Berg held the brick and stone contract with stairways by James Moore of Cleveland. The brick was furnished at \$11.75 per thousand. When taken into consideration that a majority of all materials had to be shipped up river by boat, the over all cost of the courthouse was very reasonable.

When the new safe arrived for the county recorders office, it was pulled down the street on a sled by Henry Wright's team of 28 bulls. The 6,400 pound load was nothing for them to pull according to the River Press of that date.

One facet of the building has always provided a point for discussion. As far back as April 16, 1884, "It was suggested to Monday that the new courthouse ought to have a clock in its tower for the general convenience of the public, and it seems to us that the suggestion's a good one. Imitation dials are provided for, but it's so fine a building, that we think the genuine clock ought to be finished. A first class clock, warranted for a term of years, to tell the correct time, can be put in for \$800, which is a small sum in consideration of the

general convenience that would result from it. The commissioners ought to give the matter consideration at the earliest opportunity." The \$800 must have been more than the commissioners could afford as was accounted on a July 23 issue of the River Press, "The courthouse clock is completed and our citizens can now look up at the big tower and tell the time of day--that is, if they look exactly at twenty minutes past twelve. At any other time, it would be apt to lead them astray. The dials present a handsome appearance, but they are false ones. They serve to suggest, however, what a great benefit a real clock would be, and we trust it will not be long until one is put into the tower. Such a magnificent public edifice is hardly complete without one." The cry for a clock went unanswered. As one citizen said, "I've always had a watch of my own. I don't need to look up there to find out the time."

When examining old photos of the building, one can notice changes, possibly the most dramatic being the rapid growth of the trees surrounding. They have made an overall view of the building virtually impossible. A vault section was added in the 1920's or 30's and in 1968, extensive exterior restoration was completed, which included stabilization of the foundation, painting, new roof, sanding repainting of the brick work. Interior improvements were made in 1973.

Upon completion of the courthouse, the River Press noted the county was to be congratulated upon having secured, at a reasonable cost, a handsome and excellent building, one that will serve for many years to come.

100 years have past, the building is still handsome, it still serves a tribute to those who designed, commissioned and constructed it those

many years ago and to those who have tastefully remodeled and maintained it over the century.

As we reflect on the past, we also look forward to the next 100 years of service.

Since I cannot find any original emigration documents over here I am trying to get some from stateside. I would be very pleased, if you can give me any help.


